# Driver Training

## Driver NVQ Level 2

To support your drivers in the logistics and freight industries, The Warrington Business School offers a range of flexible training to help your people improve their skills on or off the job and their performance. Good driving techniques can save lives and save your organisation time and money

The Driver NVQ has been designed to allow assessment of drivers of 7.5 tonne vehicle upwards with minimal disruption to the daily working environment carrying out their normal duties whilst at work.

Each learner will be assessed on their driving skills and advice will be given when required to maintain safety and update their skills. ( Even the most experienced driver picks up bad habits.)

### **The NVQ covers 7 mandatory units as listed below and 2 optional units if required:**

- 1 Monitoring the loading
- 2 Completing pre-driving preparation
- 3 Maintaining the safety and the security of the load, self and others
- 4 Maintaining awareness of driving conditions
- 5 Operating the vehicle controls
- 6 Driving the vehicle on public roads
- 7 Driving the vehicle in restricted spaces

### **Optional units**

- 8 Unloading the vehicle
- 9 Coupling and uncoupling the vehicle

The assessments cover driver's performance in carrying out the work and proving knowledge relevant to the industry. This is obtained through observations, verbal and written questions and testimonies. A portfolio of evidence is built up to obtain the NVQ qualification. This can be either paper based or electronic.
