What are Apprenticeships?

Apprenticeships are training programmes funded by the Government. They have been designed to provide 16–24 year olds and adults from 25yrs with a way to combine college studies and on-the-job training, to meet the needs of both employers and learners.

Why are Apprenticeships different?

Apprentices are your employees and will be trained in partnership with you to become a tradesperson in the areas your business requires. Your organisation will have skilled workers, trained to your requirements and qualified to the British Industrial Standards to support the development and growth of your business.

Why should business get involved?

Apprenticeships make good business sense as skill shortages are still one of the major threats to UK companies. Having trained employees with the relevant skills will help to fill shortages, have access to restricted sites, minimise staff turnover, reduce workplace accidents and increase productivity.

Apprenticeships are a proven way to train your team. They can enhance your organisation; make it more effective and competitive by addressing skills gaps directly.

Apprentices tend to be eager and loyal to the company investing in them, thus reducing staff turnover.

Apprentices will gain the relevant qualifications to meet the British Industrial Standards and will increase productivity and repeat business.

How do Apprenticeship work?

The programme runs for four years and is delivered at Warrington Collegiate. Assessments will take place at the College and on site and the employer will be informed of the apprentice's progress throughout their programme.
