NVQ Level 3

To support traffic office and warehouse supervisors in the logistics, and freight industries, The Warrington Business School offers a range of flexible training to help your people improve their skills on or off the job and their performance.

The Logistics Operations Management NVQ has been designed to meet the needs of the transport industry, it has been broken down into 3 mandatory units and 5 optional units each covering a particular area within the traffic office/warehouse.

Mandatory Units

- Unit Identify the logistics requirements of a supply chain
- Unit Promote and maintain health, safety, and security in logistics operations
- Unit Promote compliance of logistics operations with legislation, regulations, and organisational procedures

Optional Units

A total of 5 units to be taken from three option groups, according to the following rules:

- A minimum of 1 unit from each of Option Group 1 and Option Group 2
- 3 other units to be taken from any of Option Groups 1, 2, and 3
- A maximum of 3 units from each option group can be taken. A breakdown of the units can be obtained via the following link: www.skillsforlogistics.org/index/standards

The assessments cover performance in carrying out the work and proving knowledge, relevant to the industry. This is obtained through observations, verbal / written questions, testimonies and product evidence. From which a portfolio is built up to obtain the NVQ.
